Dear Parents:

Section 1111(h)(2) of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) requires each school district that receives Title I, Part A funding to disseminate the following information:

- Assessment results for all students together and also disaggregated by race, ethnicity, gender, disability status, migrant status, English proficiency, and economically disadvantaged
 - by performance level,
 - showing two-year trend data for each subject and grade tested,
 - with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group,
 - including the percentage of each group of students not tested.
- Graduation rates for secondary school students.
- The performance of school districts on Adequate Yearly Progress measures.
- The number and names of Title I schools identified as in need of improvement, including information on any schools identified in need of improvement.
- The professional qualifications of teachers in the state, including the percentage of teachers teaching with emergency or provisional credentials, and the percentage of classes in the state that are not taught by highly qualified teachers, including a comparison between high- and low-poverty schools.

The School Report Card previously distributed included much of this information. The Annual Performance Report, which was publicly reviewed in December and has been distributed to all campuses, also included part of this data. The Highly Qualified status of the district was also publicly reported in December.
