

# At-Risk Identification (2020-2021)

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## Indicator #1 – Readiness Testing (Blue)

- *is in prekindergarten, kindergarten or grade 1, 2, or 3 and did not perform satisfactorily on a readiness test or assessment instrument administered during the current school year*
  - Since this indicator is looking at readiness tests or assessments taken during the school year, this indicator must be evaluated each time the students are tested.
  - The campus RTI Specialist will provide this information to you.
  - This information can be mass uploaded through a LF request

## Indicator #2 – Failing 2 or more subjects (Yellow and Blue)

- *is in grade 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12 and did not maintain an average equivalent to 70 on a scale of 100 in two or more subjects in the foundation curriculum during a semester in the preceding or current school year or is not maintaining such an average in two or more subjects in the foundation curriculum in the current semester.*
  - New students: Must look at report cards for preceding school year
  - Current students: Utility runs nightly and marks At-Risk according to term grades.

## Indicator #3 – Retained (Yellow and Blue)

- *was not advanced from one grade level to the next for one or more school years;*
  - *excludes prekindergarten or kindergarten students who were not advanced to the next grade level as a result of a documented request by the student's parent (TEC 29.081 (d-1)).*
  - For students who have always been enrolled in NCISD, you can look at their Entry/With screen in Skyward. An "R" or "RR" in the school year they were retained will be indicated.
  - For students who were previously enrolled in other districts, review records that were sent to NCISD from the previous school district. The UID record, which is located in Laserfiche, will show their enrollment history prior to enrolling in NCISD.

**\*NOTE:** The UID enrollment history only shows enrollment in public or charter schools within the State of Texas.

## Indicator #4 – Non-Satisfactory Performance on State Assessment (Blue)

- *did not perform satisfactorily on an assessment instrument administered to the student under TEC Subchapter B, Chapter 39, and who has not in the previous or current school year subsequently performed on that instrument or another appropriate instrument at a level equal to at least 110 percent of the level of satisfactory performance on that instrument*
  - Testing Coordinator
  - Aware Report
  - ODS 110% Report
  - This information can be mass uploaded through a LF request

## Indicator #5 – Pregnant or Parent (Blue)

- *is pregnant or is a parent*
  - This applies to fathers as well as mothers.
  - Does not have to be the biological parent.
  - If the student is no longer a parent or pregnant due to adoption or is deceased, the student is no longer at-risk.

## Indicator #6 – DAEP (TLC) (Yellow and Blue)

- *has been placed in an alternative education program in accordance with TEC §37.006 during the preceding or current school year*

- Only mandatory placements according to the TWEDS formerly known as Appendix E in the PEIMS Data Standards qualify a student as At-Risk.
- New to district students who served a placement in the prior school year will be required to be coded manually.

#### Indicator #7 – Expulsion (JJAEP) (Yellow and Blue)

- *has been expelled in accordance with TEC §37.007 during the preceding or current school year*
  - Only mandatory placements according to Appendix E in the PEIMS Data Standards qualify a student as At-Risk.
  - New to district students who served a placement in the prior school year will be required to be coded manually.

#### Indicator #8 – Currently on parole or probation (Blue)

- *is currently on parole, probation, deferred prosecution, or other conditional release*
  - Must have a procedure in place with the assistant principal, front office staff and attendance clerk to ensure that you are notified if a parole or probation officer comes to see a student or if a student submits an attendance note stating they have attended a probation appointment.

#### Indicator #9 – Dropout (Blue)

- *was previously reported through the Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) to have dropped out of school*
  - Students in Grade 7-12 who did not resume school within the School-Start Window (last Friday in September).
  - After Fall PEIMS is complete PEIMS will send out a Presumed At-Risk list to campuses who have students that may need to be reviewed.

#### Indicator #10 – LEP (Yellow)

- *is a student of limited English proficiency, as defined by TEC §29.052*
  - EL Specialist is responsible for coding students in Skyward.
  - First, second, third and fourth year monitor students are not At-Risk.
  - It is the responsibility of the counselor to verify that all LEP students have been coded as At-Risk.

#### Indicator #11 – DPFS (Blue)

- *is in the custody or care of the Department of Family and Protective Services or has, during the current school year, been referred to the department by a school official, officer of the juvenile court, or law enforcement official*
  - All foster care students should be coded as At-Risk.
  - If a parent answers “Yes” The student is currently in the conservatorship of the DFPS during the registration process the registrar sends the counselor all “Yes” answers for confirmation.

#### Indicator #12 – Homeless (Yellow)

- *is homeless, as defined by NCLB, Title X, Part C, Section 725(2), the term “homeless children and youths”, and its subsequent amendments*
  - Notified through Laserfiche

#### Indicator #13 – Residential Facility (Blue)

- *resided in the preceding school year or resides in the current school year in a residential placement facility in the district, including a detention facility, substance abuse treatment facility, emergency shelter, psychiatric hospital, halfway house, cottage home operation, specialized child-care home, or general residential operation.*
  - Must have a procedure in place for campus staff to notify you should they receive information that a student is in one of the above mentioned facilities.

Indicator #14 – Incarcerated (Blue)

- *has been incarcerated or has a parent or guardian who has been incarcerated, within the lifetime of the student, in a penal institution as defined by Section 1.07, Penal Code.*
  - Must have a procedure in place for campus staff to notify you should they receive information that a student or student's parent or guardian meets this criteria.
