Our goal is to provide you with the steps you need to start taking advantage of the wonderful dual credit opportunities that we have to offer you.

### **New Dual Credit Student Steps:**

### Review campus course offerings at <a href="https://www.newcaneyisd.org/Page/527">https://www.newcaneyisd.org/Page/527</a>

- 1. Complete LSC Admissions Application through ApplyTexas use personal email- do not use your NCISD email
  - For Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 using the following Lone Star College link <a href="http://www.lonestar.edu/ApplyTexas.htm">http://www.lonestar.edu/ApplyTexas.htm</a>.
  - Watch the step-by-step <u>LSC Application Video</u>\* or review these <u>Google Slides</u>\* for guidance.
- 2. Check your email for your LSC username and ID number.
  - You will usually receive this within 24-48 hours of completing the application.
  - Save this information! You will need it to complete the registration paperwork.
- Satisfy <u>Bacterial Meningitis Requirement.</u> This is <u>only required</u> if you are attending an in-person or hybrid class on the college campus. Additional information can be found at <u>https://www.lonestar.edu/meningitis.htm</u>.
- 4. Students must show college readiness in reading, writing, and/or math as applicable to the course(s) the student plans to take. This can be accomplished by achieving a college readiness score on any of the following assessments. See the chart below to determine if you have demonstrated college readiness.
  - If you <u>HAVE MET</u> the qualifying scores in Math **or** Reading/Writing, talk with your high school counselor before moving forward.
  - If you <u>HAVE NOT MET</u> the qualifying scores for Math AND Reading/Writing on any assessment, go to Step 5

## ACHIEVING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SCORES DEMONSTRATES COLLEGE READINESS:

PSAT/NMSQT: Evidence-Based Reading/Writing: 460, Math: 510

SAT: Evidence-Based Reading/Writing: 480, Math: 530

ACT: English & Reading Combined: 40; Math:22

STAAR EOC: English II: 4000, Algebra I: 4000 and passing grade in Algebra II

TSIA2: ELAR: 945+ or <945 with Diagnostic 5+

ESSAY: 5+

MATH: 950+ or <950 with Diagnostic 6

**PSAT/NMSQT & SAT scores:** <u>collegeboard.org</u> \*sign into student account

**ACT scores:** <u>my.act.org</u> \*sign into student account

**STAAR EOC:** Skyward (view transcript)

- 5. If not met the qualifying scores, complete the Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA)\*
  - This is **only required** for students taking the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA2) <a href="https://practice.accuplacer.org/login">https://practice.accuplacer.org/login</a>.
    - i.Create an account using personal email account *(do NOT use NCISD email)* and create PAA password.
    - ii. Login > select 3rd option Texas Success Initiative 2.0
    - iii. Save the certificate of completion

### 6. Placement Testing (TSIA2)

- TSI Testing can be completed in-person at a LSC campus or via remote proctoring. Lone Star College waives the testing fee for all first-time dual credit testers; however, remote proctoring has a fee of \$25 per administration.
  - i. After you have completed the Pre-Assessment Activity AND prior to TSIA2 testing, you will need a testing referral provided by a Lone Star College advisor.
  - ii. Using your LSC email, email <u>KC-DualCredit@lonestar.edu</u> with the following information:
    - 1. LSC ID
    - DOB (MM/DD/YYYY)
    - 3. SECTION(S) TO TEST: ELAR (English, Language Arts, and Reading), MATH OR BOTH? \*what section(s) do you need to demonstrate college readiness?
    - 4. IS THIS A RETEST? If yes, did you previously test at your high school or LSC College?

iii. Retesting is \$10 per section.

7. Turn in your qualifying TSIA2 scores to your counselor who will provide further instructions.
